2. Important Notes for Applicants

- (1) First, contact and consult with your prospective faculty advisor. Have him / her sign or put their seal on your application form before you submit it.
- (2) Prior to applying, pay your entrance examination fee by bank transfer.
- (3) Once you have the documents listed in pages 44–45, place the documents in the pre-addressed “Application Documents Enclosed” envelope, and send it by postal mail, or bring it in person to the Admission Affairs Division by the specific deadline. The office is open weekdays from 9 am–5 pm. Please note that entrance examination fees may not be paid in cash.
- (4) In principle, entrance examination fees are not refundable once you have submitted your application, nor are admission documents returned.

3. Application Eligibility

International students who meet the Graduate School of Veterinary Medicine Course eligibility requirements given in the Rakuno Gakuen University Graduate School Admissions Guidelines, as well as meet the following conditions, may apply. Applicants who have not consulted with a prospective faculty advisor in the relevant research field in advance will not be considered.

- (1) Foreign nationals

The applicants who hold citizenship in a foreign country, fall into at least one of the following categories, and either have obtained or are able to obtain the status of residence “Student” under the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act.

[Doctoral Course]

- a. Applicants who have completed 18 years of education in foreign countries, or are expected to complete said courses; or who have acquired a Master's degree, a professional degree or an equivalent degree, or are in the process of earning said degree.
- b. Applicants who have graduated, or are expected to graduate, from a university or other institution in a foreign country after completing a five-year or longer program in veteri-

nary medicine or a related field and who have obtained, or are expected to obtain, a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent degree, including those whose education has been recognized by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).

- c. Applicants who have been designated by MEXT.
- d. Applicants who have been recognized by the Graduate School, through an individual eligibility screening process, as possessing academic ability equivalent to or higher than that of a graduate of a six-year undergraduate program in veterinary medicine, medicine, dentistry, or pharmaceutical sciences, and who will be at least 24 years of age at the time of enrollment.

[Master's Course]

- a. Applicants who have completed 16 years of education in foreign countries.
- b. Applicants who have graduated, or are expected to graduate, from a university or other institution in foreign countries after completing a program of at least three years, thereby earning a Bachelor's degree or an equivalent degree; this includes individuals whose combined education and research activities have been certified by a foreign government, a relevant institution, or the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).
- c. Applicants who have been designated by MEXT.
- d. Applicants who have been recognized by the Graduate School, through an individual eligibility screening process, as possessing academic ability equivalent to or higher than that of a university graduate, and who will be at least 22 years of age at the time of enrollment.

5. Selection Criteria and Methods

Applicants will be screened and selected based on the documents submitted. If deemed necessary, applicants may be required to submit additional documents or information on a case-by-case basis. An in-person interview or written examination may also be required.

Part-time Work

International students who are entering Japan for the first time to reside/study are required to receive guidance from their academic advisor on general knowledge and social norms in Japan. This guidance takes at least three months, during which part-time work is not permitted.

6. Entrance Examination Fee : JPY 30,000

- (1) Please make the payment only after consulting with your prospective faculty advisor.
- (2) Take the application form, Photo Sheet, entrance examination fee receipt, and bank transfer form to a bank. Fill in the required information and make the payment.
- (3) Cash, postal transfers, checks, and other forms of payment are not accepted. Payment cannot be made via ATM.
- (4) Confirm that the bank stamp indicating payment appears on the Photo Sheet. This stamp serves as proof that the entrance examination fee has been paid.
- (5) Be sure to keep your entrance examination fee receipt, as it may be required to verify payment if your application documents or examination admission ticket do not arrive.
- (6) Entrance examination fees are non-refundable once paid.

● Tuition Payment System Fee (Contact : Financial Affairs Division 011-386-4114)

This fee covers the cost of the tuition payment system used for paying tuition and other academic fees. It is collected in the first semester of each academic year.

● Other Fees

The University collects these fees on behalf of various associations. Please pay these fees at the time of enrollment procedures and when paying academic fees.

1. Health Care Co-op Fee (Contact : Student Support Affairs Division 011-388-4122)

This fee is collected as a membership fee for the Health Care Co-op, whose purpose is to provide medical payments in the event of student illness, injury, or death in the spirit of student mutual aid as well as to promote health and well-being.

2. Student Life Support Fee (Contact : Student Support Affairs Division 011-388-4122)

This fee is collected to support student life. Major programs include offering support for extracurricular activities, enrollment in Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research, and offering the San-ai Fund (a loan program).

3. Alumni Association Fee (Contact : Rakuno Gakuen University Alumni Association 011-386-1196)

This fee is collected on behalf of the Alumni Association, whose purpose is to contribute to the development of the University while deepening interaction and friendship among members. A lifetime membership fee of 10,000 yen is collected in the second semester of the final year. As a rule, this fee is non-refundable.

4. Alumni Association Operating Fee (Contact : Rakuno Gakuen University Alumni Association 011-386-1196)

This fee is collected on behalf of the Alumni Association to cover its operating costs, while deepening interaction and friendship among alumni and contributing to the development of the University.
